

AP 5012 - Special Admission: Applicants Not Meeting Minimum Assessment Scores to be Placed in College Level Courses

1. The applicant follows the admission and steps to register processes for new students.
 - a. Applicants in need of accommodations for placement testing are referred to Disability Services.
2. If after taking the Chemeketa assessment tests, an applicant scores below college-level the applicant receives advising for next steps, re-test options, and/or referral for accommodation services.
 - a. Applicants who would benefit from review of study tools are advised to study and re-test with the standardized placement test.
 - b. Applicants who are identified as needing an Alternative Placement Test (APT) are advised to return another day to take the APT to determine placements in both reading and writing.
 - c. Applicants who place below pre-college level with the APT are advised to register for non-credit Adult Skills Education coursework.
 - d. Applicants who place into pre-college credit level courses are advised to continue with steps to register for credit classes (PRO #5110).
