ACCESS CHEMEKETA'S WIRELESS NETWORK

For Students:

1. Click on the network connections icon 
2. Click on CCC-Connect > click on Connect (may need to scroll down)
3. Accept Terms (Start) in the welcome screen then continue through the setup
 - a. If there is no welcome screen, Open the browser, wifi.chemeketa.edu
4. Enter your My Chemeketa login and password > click on Continue
5. Click on Download/Install button
 - a. Mac OS: go into Downloads > double click on on Cloudpath
 - b. Windows: click on Run in the pop up on the bottom of the browser
6. Wait for the second  and you should be connected to CCC-Student
 - Apple Products, you need to change the network to CCC-Student from CCC-Connect
 - If you have difficulties with these instructions or your device, please see IT Help Desk in Bldg. 22.

Purchase your textbooks and supplies

Building 1–Bookstore (1st floor)

Purchase your textbooks and supplies in the Bookstore, or online at bookstore.chemeketa.edu. If needed, please discuss financial assistance options with your advisor.

Order your parking permit

Bldg. 2, Public Safety (1st floor)

You are welcome to use the computers at the Public Safety window to order your parking permit online. Our Public Safety staff is available to assist you.

Here's how: Log in to My Chemeketa > click on the "Services" tab > select "Safety" and follow the instructions. When done, **you must print** your temporary permit to use until your permanent permit comes in the mail.

Print your class schedule

Building 1, Bookstore or Building 2, Rm. 115 (1st floor)

Print your class schedule and go on a campus tour to find your classes, buy or check out textbooks, and ensure that you have all your classes. Due to low enrollment, some classes may be canceled. If you are missing classes, please see an academic advisor in Bldg. 2, Rm. 115. Not being registered for the minimum number of credits required can affect your financial aid. You are welcome to print your class schedule at the Advising Center or at the Kiosk located in the Bookstore or on your own.

Here's how: Log in to My Chemeketa > click on "Schedule" located on the "Classes" tab > select the appropriate term from the drop down > select from Agenda, Week, List, or Block > click on the "Print" button.

Download EAB Navigate Student App

Bldg. 2, Lobby (1st floor)

Make an appointment with an advisor, check out your success team, access resources, review any to-do items or holds in your account, and more!

Here's how: Download the app from the Apple Store or Google Play > search "Navigate Student" > once it downloads, search "Chemeketa" > log in with your Chemeketa credentials.

To use the web app, go to login.chemeketa.edu and log in with your Chemeketa credentials and select the EAB Navigate - Student tile.

Go on a campus tour

- Check on your financial aid status** Building 2, Rm. 200 (2nd floor)
To ensure that your financial aid is disbursed on time, it is necessary to review your financial aid requirements before the term begins. You can check with the Financial Aid Office or on your own.
- Here's how: Log in to My Chemeketa > click on the "Services" tab > click on "Financial Aid" > select the appropriate academic year from the drop down. If you need assistance, stop by the Financial Aid Office any time from 8 am–5 pm or call 503.399.5018.
- Pay your student balance** Building 2, Rm. 200 (2nd floor)
Payment is due before the first day of the term or within 10 days of class registration, whichever is later, to avoid a \$25 late fee. If you applied for financial aid and see a balance in your student account, or have not yet accepted your award, please visit the Financial Aid Office.

- Check out a laptop and/or textbooks to use during fall term** Bldg. 9, Library (2nd floor)
If you need a laptop and/or textbooks for the fall term, the Library may accommodate your needs. You need your virtual student ID to check out items from the Library. To access this free service, you must be registered for fall term courses and availability is on a first-come, first-served basis.
- Log in to Canvas and check your courses before classes start** Bldg. 9, Library (2nd floor)
Canvas is an online learning platform where you can access instructor-provided materials, view course syllabi and requirements, and view your grades. Due to low enrollment, classes may be canceled. If you are missing classes, see an academic advisor in Bldg. 2, Rm. 115.

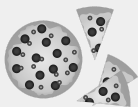
