TRANSFER GUIDE FOR  
BACHELOR'S DEGREE IN NURSING  
University of Portland - Nursing

Admittance into the upper division nursing coursework for the Bachelor of Science in Nursing degree is dependent upon the following minimum requirements:

- A cumulative GPA of 3.0\* or above.
- A cumulative GPA of 3.0\* or above in the required sciences with a minimum grade of C in each required science course. Pass/No Pass is not allowed.
- Completion of all prerequisite courses. Lower division credit may be taken at any accredited college or university.
- All prerequisite courses must be graded with a grade of C or higher. Pass/No Pass is not allowed.
- Application deadline is February 1<sup>st</sup>.

**\*Please note that these are the minimum requirements. Admission to the program is highly competitive with average GPAs significantly higher than the requirement.**

<b>ELECTIVES</b> To transfer into the upper division nursing coursework (junior status) a minimum of 60 semester hours (90-quarter hours) are required. Courses in writing, speech, science, foreign languages, or the social sciences are recommended as electives. If you have received AP or CLEP credits, these hours may count toward the total elective hours.
